## MESSAGE FROM PASTOR MIKE.....

**What is the reason for The Church?** I want to focus on the reason for The Church. The reason for the Church, Trinity or any church, is to aid our following of Christ through

- worship,
- study and preaching,
- service,
- and fellowship.

Each of these words has been given in Acts 2-4, Luke's Charter for The Church. Worship, study and preaching, service, and fellowship all have to do with becoming disciples of Jesus Christ, following Christ and becoming more and more the people Christ would have us be and become.

In an article entitled *Becoming God's Church: A New Congregation Finds its Place in God's Unfolding Story*, Rev. Roy Terry IV \*\* defines the Church by taking the fresh view of a pastor leading a brand new church start. Roy says this: "If the church is serious about its full and humble participation in God's story, then the church really does have something to offer! If this is all about God, and not about establishing human social clubs and institutions, then it opens the door for the serious work of inviting everyone to worship. As vessels for the work of the Lord, the practices that transcend time form the church into a community that is hospitable to all who come. If this is the focus, then worship itself becomes the invitation, and, in gathering, the church gives flesh to those gifted practices."

So back to my original question: *What is the reason for The Church?* What do you think? Check out the essential definition of the Church in Acts Chapters 2 through 4. You will find the church's charter in this account by Luke, the writer of the third gospel. These chapters of the New Testament speak about the Holy Spirit blessing us with God's gifts of the Spirit or signs of The Holy Spirit's power. Once again these signs of the Holy Spirit's power were a foursome: the proclaiming of the gospel, faithful worship with baptism and supper at its center, service to the neighbor in need, and a life together of caring and sharing. The Church's reason for existing is to act as a channel for these four signs and gifts of the Holy Spirit.

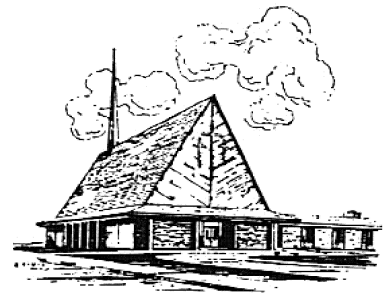

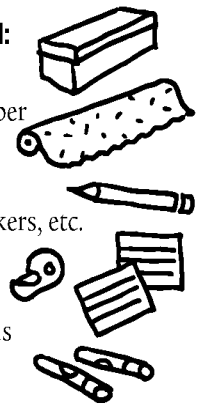

## PRAYER BOX

Family prayer time is a good habit. Make it fun with this activity for all family members. They can use this special box whenever they have a prayer request.

### What you need:

- Shoebox
- Wrapping paper
- Scissors
- Tape
- Stickers, markers, etc. (optional)
- Index cards
- Pencils or pens



### What you do:

1. Wrap the shoebox like a present. Be sure to wrap the lid separately so it can be removed.
2. Let the whole family help decorate the box. You can write Bible verses about prayer, draw pictures, glue on pictures or add stickers. Be creative!
3. Put the box in a prominent location of your house. Keep a pile of index cards and pencils or pens near the box.
4. Whenever a family member has a prayer request, he or she can write or draw it on a card and put it inside the box.
5. Family members can share the cards in a prayer circle, or people can take turns praying for all the requests. Throughout the week, family members can check the box for new prayer needs.

Answers: "He and all his family were devout and God-fearing; he gave generously to those in need and prayed to God regularly." Acts 10:2, NIV

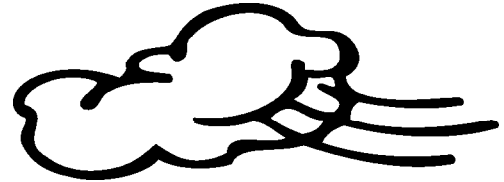
